**MOTION FOR BIOGRAPHICALS AND BCBSD PROFORMA
FINANCIALS TO BE DECLARED CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENTS**

Highmark Inc. (“Highmark”), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Paragraph 10 of the Pre-Hearing Order entered in this matter on October 20, 2010 (the “Pre-Hearing Order”), hereby files this Motion for Biographicals and BCBSD Proforma Financials to be Declared Confidential Documents (the “Motion”). In support of the Motion, Highmark respectfully represents as follows:

RELEVANT BACKGROUND

1. On October 7, 2010, Highmark filed a Statement Regarding the Affiliation of BCBSD, Inc. d/b/a Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Delaware (“BCBSD”) with Highmark (the “Affiliation Statement”) in the Delaware Insurance Department (the “Insurance Department”), thereby seeking approval from the Delaware Insurance Commissioner, Karen Weldin Stewart (the “Commissioner”), of the proposed affiliation of BCBSD, Inc., with Highmark (the “Affiliation”).

2. On October 20, 2010, the Commissioner entered the Pre-Hearing Order. Paragraph 10 of the Pre-Hearing Order provides:

Documentary evidence submitted into the record by any Party prior to, at or subsequent to the hearing shall be deemed to be a “public record” within the meaning of 29 Del. C. § 10002(g) and any applicable regulations, unless the Hearing Officer shall determine otherwise upon the application of any Party. Upon motion of a Party, and thereafter by order of the Hearing Officer, those documents considered by the Hearing Officer as part of the hearing record which are deemed to be documents which are not “public records” pursuant to applicable law shall be identified by title and date in a document filed herein.

3. On November 4, 2010, the Commissioner entered an order appointing the Hon. Battle R. Robinson as Hearing Officer in this matter pursuant to 29 Del. C. §10125(a).

4. Highmark, contemporaneously with the filing of this Motion, and pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Scheduling Order entered by the Hearing Officer dated January 5, 2011, is filing a supplement (referred to as Supplemental Filing No. 1) containing Exhibits 8 and 9 to the Affiliation Statement. Attached as Exhibit 8 to the Affiliation Statement are biographical affidavits of the directors and executive officers of Highmark (the “Biographical”), and attached as Exhibit 9 to the Affiliation Statement are BCBSD projected balance sheets and income statements, inclusive of overview, assumptions and projected risk-based capital ratios for 2010 through 2015 (the “BCBSD Proforma Financials”). The Biographicals are attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and the BCBSD Proforma Financials are attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

5. By this Motion, Highmark respectfully requests entry of an order: (i) declaring that the Biographicals and the BCBSD Proforma Financials as “Confidential Documents”; and (ii) prohibiting the Biographicals and the BCBSD Proforma Financials from being deemed, handled, or otherwise treated as “public records” within the meaning of 29 Del. C. § 10002(g).

BASIS FOR RELIEF REQUESTED

5. Unless the Hearing Officer determines otherwise upon the application of any Party, documentary evidence submitted in this matter shall be deemed to be a “public record” within the meaning of 29 Del. C. § 10002(g) and any applicable regulations. See Pre-Hearing Order, ¶ 10. Paragraph 10 further provides that upon motion, and thereafter by order of the Hearing Officer, those documents considered by the Hearing Officer as part of the hearing record which are deemed to be documents which are not “public records” shall be identified by title and date. Id. Furthermore, and pursuant to Section 10112 of the Delaware Administrative Procedures Act, an

agency may decline to make available documents and other materials which are specifically exempt from disclosure by law. See 29 Del. C. § 10112(b)(4).


6. The Biographical are tantamount to personnel files, the disclosure of which would constitute an invasion of personal privacy. Similarly, the BCBSD Proforma Financials contain trade secrets and commercial and financial information which is privileged and confidential in nature. Highmark respectfully submits that entry of an order declaring the Biographicals and the BCBSD Proforma Financials as “Confidential Documents” and prohibiting them from being deemed, handled, or otherwise treated as “public records” within the meaning of 29 Del. C. § 10002(g) is therefore necessary and appropriate under the circumstances.¹

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Highmark respectfully requests the Hearing Officer to enter an order, a proposed form of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 4: (i) declaring that the Biographicals and the BCBSD Proforma Financials as “Confidential Documents”; (ii) prohibiting the Biographicals and the BCBSD Proforma Financials from being deemed, handled, or otherwise treated as “public records” within the meaning of 29 Del. C. § 10002(g); and (iii) granting such other and further relief as is deemed just and proper.
