INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING PROOF OF CLAIM

TO: POLICYHOLDERS AND OTHER POTENTIAL CREDITORS OF
UNITED CONTRACTORS INSURANCE COMPANY, INC.,
A RISK RETENTION GROUP, IN LIQUIDATION

DATE: SEPTEMBER 4, 2013

United Contractors Insurance Company, Inc., a Risk Retention Group ("UCIC") has been ordered liquidated by the Court of Chancery of the State of Delaware in the matter now captioned as "In the Matter of the Liquidation of United Contractors Insurance Company, Inc., a Risk Retention Group, C.A. No. 8802-CS." The Court appointed The Honorable Karen Weldin Stewart, CIR-ML, Insurance Commissioner of the State of Delaware, as the Receiver (the "Receiver") of UCIC. In the August 21, 2013, Liquidation and Injunction Order, as modified by the Orders dated August 22, 2013, and August 29, 2013, the Court also ordered that the Bar Date for filing all claims against UCIC with the Receiver shall be **February 27, 2015**.

The proof of claim form must be completed in accordance with the instructions, must be signed under oath, and must be returned to the address indicated on the proof of claim form on or before the Bar Date of February 27, 2015, so that the proof of claim and supporting documentation are RECEIVED by the UCIC estate by that date, or your claim will be barred from sharing in any distributions of assets from the UCIC estate unless assets become available to pay Class VII (late-filed) claims.

YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF YOUR CLAIM AGAINST UCIC.

Any claimant who fails to file a proof of claim as required shall be forever barred from sharing in the assets of the UCIC estate unless assets become available for distribution to the Class VII (late-filed) claims.

Each section of the proof of claim should be completed. If a section is not applicable, please so state. A separate proof of claim form should be completed for each claim against UCIC. (If you believe you have more than one claim, you should photocopy the proof of claim form for the additional claims.) You may use photocopies of the Proof of Claim form, but the claimant's signature and the notarization submitted to the Receiver must be the original signature and notarization. All interested parties are encouraged to complete and send in their proof of claim forms as soon as possible. A fillable PDF version of the Proof of Claim form will be posted on the website listed below.

Assets are distributed in accordance with the priority classes established in the Delaware Insurance Code. No priority class will share in any distribution of assets unless and until all higher priority classes have been satisfied in full. The Liquidation and Injunction Order, the Order setting the Bar Date and providing for the cancellation of insurance policies and contracts of insurance, and other relevant documentation can be found on the web page for UCIC on the Delaware Insurance Department website at:
