

What is Covered Under Your Health Insurance Plan?

Did you know that your major medical health insurance policy is now required to cover certain childhood services?

Under the Delaware Title 18 Insurance Code the services noted below must be available to all children insured under a major medical health insurance policy issued in the state:

- **Autism Screening:** 18 months and 24 months
- **CA125 Ovarian Cancer Screening**
- **Hearing Aid Coverage:** \$1000.00 per hearing aid, per ear, every 3 years for covered dependents less than 24 years old
- **Immunizations covered at 100%:** Birth to age 18
 - Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis
 - Influenza
 - Haemophilus influenzae Type B
 - Measles, Mumps, Rubella
 - Hepatitis A
 - Meningococcal
 - Hepatitis B
 - Pneumococcal
 - Human Papillomavirus
 - Rotavirus
 - Polio
 - Varicella
- **Lead Poisoning Screening:** 12 months – 6 years
- **Newborn and Infant Hearing Screening:** Birth – Discharge
- **Phenylketonuria (PKU) and Other Inherited Metabolic Diseases**
- **Screenings of Infants and Toddlers for Developmental Delays:** Ages 9 months, 18 months, 30 months
